GETTING THERE

Oxford Bus Museum is immediately adjacent to Hanborough Railway Station, and is accessed through one small part of the station car park.

Parking is extremely limited on-site, and visitors will be asked to park in the larger nearby station car park, accessed via the yellow arrow on the map. Parking here is chargeable, at a rate of £2.90 for the Sunday [at time of writing].

Most exhibitors will, however, be able to park on-site free of charge. This will be on a first-come, first served basis. The front of the museum will be used for drop-off of displays, before exhibitors are directed to park.

Hanborough station has links to a variety of national destinations, whilst the S7 bus service provides regular links to Oxford and Witney.



MUSEUM ENTRY

Visitors will be asked to pay the museum standard admission fee, see their website for further details. Exhibitors/ trade stands will gain free admission to the museum, and will be provided with a wristband to wear for the day, upto a maximum of two per stand.

The museum will be operating its normal range of activities throughout the day to enhance the offer.

REFRESHMENTS

The museum will be providing a range of refreshments, including hot and cold drinks, sandwiches, etc. at their on-site cafe.

For exhibitors and traders, free tea and coffee, as well as lunch (details TBC), will be provided free of charge as a thank you for supporting the event.

DISPLAYS/ TRADE STANDS

Displays and trade stands are free to book, and will be spread into several zones throughout the museum. There are both heated and unheated spaces at the museum - we know it is likely to be cold, and hence will use the heated space first.

If it is necessary to use unheated space, exhibitors will be prioritised for the heated areas over trade stands. We appreciate this is not ideal - as this is a new event, we do not yet know how popular it will be. If we need the unheated space, we will look into options for providing some level of heat (e.g. space heaters) to make things manageable.

The museum has a limited number of tables and chairs available in a variety of sizes - if you have your own, it would be a massive help. For this reason, please let us know the approximate size of the display you would like to bring when booking, and if you do/ dont need tables/ chairs. Power will not be available at this event.
