34904 Leyland Olympian Coach SOUTHERN VECTIS

Continuing to build our fleet of models in Southern Vectis livery this coach seated Leyland Olympian is decorated in the green and cream "Privatisation livery" of the mid 1980's. Registered G717 WDL, fleet number 717 works route 4 to Ryde via Osbourne. **NOVEMBER RELEASE.**



16128 Leyland PD2 Highbridge SOUTHDOWN

31504 RM Routemaster LONDON TRANSPORT

ISLE OF WIGHT ISLAND LINE

In the summer of 2000 the 1930's built trains working on the Isle of Wight began to be replaced with standard 1938 stock tube trains. These 1938 carriages were made into sets of A & D driving motor carriages directly coupled and numbered 001 upwards.

The discovery of many Dinosaur remains gave the Isle of Wight a new focus for visitors. To build on this attraction, as visitor numbers increased, several of the train sets were decorated into an eye catching Dinosaur livery. It is a testament to British design and engineering that these seventy year old trains are still efficiently working in regular daily service.
